FORT SCHUYLER TRAINING DAY – SUNY MARITIME COLLEGE - SAT. 03/14/2008

WHAT: Training Day for Sea Scouts and Adult Leaders

WHEN: Saturday March 14, 2009. 0800 – 1730 (8AM to 5:30PM)

WHERE: SUNY Maritime College, Fort Schuyler, Bronx NY

DIRECTIONS from NJ & Manhattan: Take I-95N to the Throgs Neck Bridge exit. Follow I-295 to the Harding Ave. Exit (the last exit before the toll booth) and turn right onto the service road. At the first traffic light, turn left onto Pennyfield Avenue and follow it all the way to the college. Be prepared to show ID at the security gate.

DIRECTIONS from Long Island: Cross the Throgs Neck Bridge, take the first exit. Follow the service road to the light at Prentiss Ave. At the traffic light, turn left and cross over the highway. On the other side of the overpass, bear left onto Pennyfield Avenue and follow it all the way to the college. Be prepared to show ID at the security gate.

ON CAMPUS: Follow the road along the sea wall until you reach the parking lot next to the fort. Enter the fort and proceed to the center entry port in the middle of the courtyard. Cross over the interior courtyard, past the flagpole, to the doors directly across from the entry port. There will be signs posted.

WHY: Training for youth in skills needed to complete Sea Scout Advancement requirements. This event is a Practice Learning Session with lots of hands-on exercises. We strongly suggest that these are not segments for the novice, you need to know the terms; read beforehand Chapter 4 in the **Sea Scout Manual** and bring the book with you as a resource.

COST: \$15.00 per person, covers lunch*, materials & rental fee for the classrooms. Advance Registration is required for this course by March 1, 2009 as we need to provide a final headcount to the college for lunch preparation. Send your fees (checks made payable to “Liberty Flotilla”) and forms to Deidre Buchner, 512 Drake Avenue, Roselle, NJ 07203. Only paid reservations with proper documents will be considered “confirmed”.

*Lunch will be held at the SUNY College Dining Hall and registered scouts will be provided with a variety of tasty selections from the salad bar, fresh soup, deli buffet, hot entrée, fruit, desserts, coffee and fountain beverages. Paid participants will receive a wrist band that will allow them entry into the cafeteria meal.
